Guimaras sustained its **economic growth** in **2024**, recording a **3.9% increase** in **Gross Domestic Product (GDP)**, which raised the province's GDP from ₱17.46 billion in 2023 to ₱18.15 billion in 2024. This generated an additional P0.69 billion in economic output and accounted for **2.8%** of **Western Visayas' total GDP**, reflecting the province's continued contribution to the regional economy.

Growth was **primarily driven** by the **Services sector**, which contributed **3.4 percentage points** to overall growth. The province's steady economic growth shows its resilience and strengthens its position as an emerging destination for investment and business opportunities.

Per Capita GDP In Philippine Peso



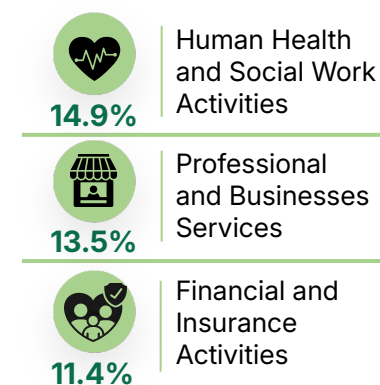

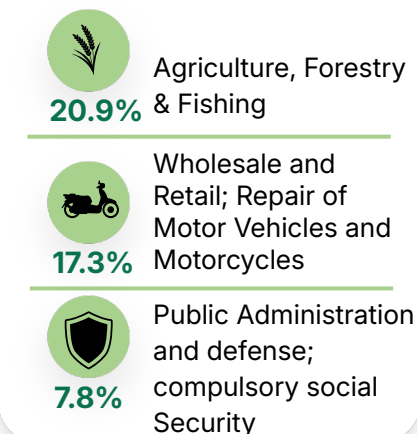
Top (3) Three Industries with the Largest Contribution to GDP Growth



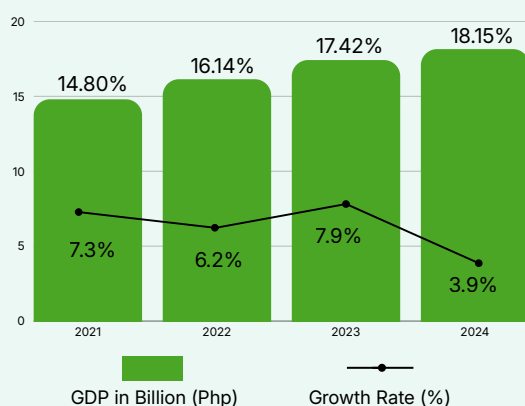
Fastest Fastest-Growing Industries in Guimaras 2024



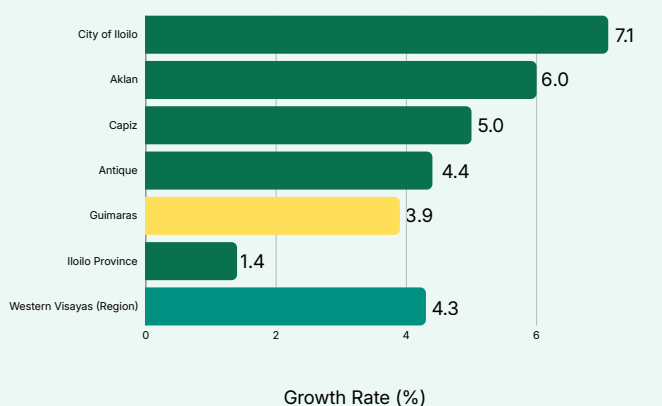
Top (3) Three Industries with Largest Share
